What is Webex?

WebEx Communications Inc. is a Cisco company that provides on-demand collaboration, online meeting, web conferencing and video conferencing applications.

What computer system can be used for the Webinars?

Webex allows you to use any computer operating system.

If I sign up for a Webinar can more then one person view the Webinar and receive credits?

No.. To receive your CEU hours and or BACB Type Two Credits each participant has to register individually so we are able to track attendance.

How do you know I attended the Webinar Workshop?

We verify attendance once you log in into the Webinar from your computer.. If you leave the Webinar before it's completion you will not receive your credits. We also ask polling questions which must be answered during the Webinar to confirm your attendance through-out.
